Water Tank

Unlike plastic, which is often used to manufacture water tanks in India, stainless steel does not degrade after long term exposure to sunlight. The quality of the water in the tank is also better because stainless does not absorb pollutants, chemical, pesticides or other contaminants.

This is particularly important considering the tanks are used to store drinking water.

The tanks cost marginally more than a plastic tank but the long life and quality of the water are significant benefits. Capacities of 500, 1,000, 1,500, 2,000 and 2,500 litres are available.
