As a result, the airport is greatly affected by salinity and it is necessary to use an exterior that can endure the corrosiveness of salt. Stainless steel is used for the exterior of the passenger terminal and transportation center. The atmosphere of the entire airport, like that of a splendid future city, is also mainly evoked by the stainless steel exterior.
