Beijing Boulder Art

World Art Sculpture Park, China

This amazing piece was created by the Beijing Sino Sculpture Group and features a stainless steel panel 25 metres long and six metres high, beautifully

polished to a mirror finish. It looks for all the world as though a magic boulder has been split in half, apparently revealing a magnificent jewel within. This piece has been placed in the private garden of Corporate Structure – like something out of The Living Desert, the first of two movies made by Disney, featuring only flora and fauna, with no people or animations. It was the precursor of the great series subsequently created for the BBC by Sir David Attenborough, although, of course, Attenborough included people in his feature films.


